ENCHANTED NEW MEXICO

MAY 11th

This epic six-night, six-day American adventure begins at the lavish Relais & Châteaux, Inn of the Five Graces in Santa Fe, New Mexico, the oldest continuously inhabited city in the United States and the territory first occupied by the Indigenous Tanoan Peoples from 900 C.E.

MAY 12th

The first day on the road, we leave from Santa Fe toward open vistas, morphing into serpentine roads, cradled between cliffs of massive granite boulders and the iconic Rio Grande River, climbing to the high elevations of Taos and the Sangre de Cristo Mountains in the land of great "influencers", as Aldous Huxley, D.H. Lawrence, Georgia O'Keeffe and legendary American frontiersman, Kit Carson. Travelling across Carson National Forest in the magnificent 84-miles long Enchanted Circle. Our way back to Santa Fe will be no less astonishing, going through the high desert plains of Carson National Forest, across New Mexico's famed "High Road." A culinary adventure will crown the day, in internationally celebrated restaurant, Sazón, just before settling back into the Inn of the Five Graces.

MARVELOUS COLORADO

MAY 13th-14th

We say adiós to Santa Fe, as we make our way north to Colorado, crossing 600 feet above the stunning Rio Grande Gorge, traversing the vast open plains of the Jicarilla Apache Nation Reservation and cresting the western Great Divide at over 8,000 feet. We navigate into Colorado's magnificent San Juan National Forest, to the restored 1800s ghost town of Dunton, Colorado for two intoxicating evenings surrounded by some of Colorado's most majestic high peaks, at the sublime Relais & Chateaux, Dunton Hot Springs Resort.



MONUMENTAL UTAH

MAY 15th

Departing Colorado and Durango Hot Springs, we make our way southwest across the vast Colorado Plateau through the Ute Mountain Reservation, home to the Ute Indigenous People dating to 1500 C.E. We cross into Utah and the Navajo Nation Reservation, as we make our way into the breathtaking Monument Valley.

WIDE OPEN ARIZONA

MAY 15th-16th

Crossing through Monument Valley, we dip into northern Arizona continuing through the Navajo Nation Reservation towards the mighty Colorado River, where we cross the massive 710-foot-high, 1,560-foot-long Glen Canyon Dam that holds back the second largest man-made reservoir in America, the 13.6 million acre Lake Powell. We continue a short distance as we cross back into Utah on the way to our final destination, the resplendent Amangiri Resort, located in Utah's Grand Staircase-Escalante National Monument, the world's foremost location in referencing the history of the earth, dating back 275-50 million years ago.
